In preparation for your visit please follow the steps below. Please note that not all may apply to you. All outside images/or slides (if applicable) will be reviewed, which may incur separate fees not covered by your insurance carrier. *Be sure to ask about this.*

Please Fax the following: Attention, Sylvia Alvarez: 212.342.4164.

- Fax all breast imaging reports (mammograms, sonograms and MRI, etc., going back the number of years all comparisons were done, if applicable).
 - Fax all pathology reports for all biopsies (biopsies by radiologist or surgeon)
 - Request all films to be placed on a CD (DIACOM FORMAT only). If this is not possible, we will need the original films.
 - Request all pathology slides (If applicable).
 - Fax a current copy of your medical insurance card(s), front and back, along with your complete mailing address and an email (if applicable).
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After receiving all the information, our patient navigator, will call or email you detailed instructions.

You will be called with the results of your reviewed, submitted medical records. You may be asked to undergo additional testing before seeing one of our clinicians.

We will discuss with you, in detail, all the findings and work with you to define your best plan for care.

It is strongly suggested that you bring with you a list of questions or concerns on the day of your appointment to discuss with the clinician.

Translators are available if required.

The Patient Portal:

Ask the staff to invite you into the Patient Portal so that we can communicate with you about your appointments, medical care, test results, and answer your questions.
